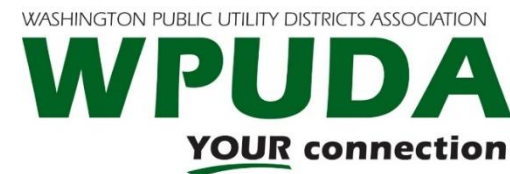

- Population growth
- Climate change
- Increasing water quality impacts
- State Supreme Court's *Foster* decision limits municipal water suppliers' ability to provide necessary water supply
- Approximately 70 municipal water providers will need additional water supply within 10 years

# WPUDA Water Priorities for the 2025 Legislative Session

- Protect the Public Works Assistance Account for its intended purpose
  - Support the Public Works Board's \$400 million capital budget request to fund necessary infrastructure projects
  - Ensure adequate water supply availability for municipal water supply purposes
  - Funding for utility relocations to facilitate fish culvert repair projects
